- **Two areas of stewardship for lesson focus: Creation and Money.**
- **Define Stewardship**

(1) Creation

- On pg. 299 in your student handbook write definitions for these 3 words: Stewardship, Creation, Praise.
- In your student Bible, read Psalm 148 on pg. 1009. Circle the words that describe our present weather!
- In the open space on pg. 1009 write down two things: (1)Your favorite thing that God created and (2)one thing you do to help the earth be healthier

(2) Money

- Read pg. 299 in your student handbook and in the middle paragraph, underline the things that God gives you.
- Find room on the page to add one more definition for the word: tithe.
- In your student Bible, read 1 Timothy 6:10 on pg. 1958 and underline it.
- In your student book, on p. 261, write down what you spend the most money on every week.

(3) Define Stewardship

Be prepared to discuss your definition of Stewardship

Sample Definitions:

- the job of supervising or taking care of something, such as an organization or property: "responsible stewardship of our public lands"
- Merriam Webster's dictionary defines it as follows: Stewardship: ... the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care. – When we act in the role of steward it means that we have been entrusted with something that does not belong to us.
