FAITH IN LIFE 3 – "Forgiveness"

We forgive because we have been forgiven. Jesus commands us to forgive one another more than he tells us to ask forgiveness from God. Let's face it, forgiving others is difficult. This lesson will focus on how we have been forgiven, and how we are called to extend that forgiveness to others.

2. Look up and write a short definition of these words in the blank areas at the bottom of page 204 in your student book:

3. There are two versions of the Lord's Prayer in the bible. Read Matthew 6:9-15 in your Bible (page 1614) and underline or circle what is to be forgiven. Then read Luke 11:1-4 in your Bible (page 1721) and underline or circle what is to be forgiven. Think about why those different words are used.

4. Think about these two questions:

- 1. Does forgiving someone mean forgetting what they have done? Is that desirable or possible? Why or why not?
- 2. If someone forgives you, does that give you permission to do the same thing again?
